The Really Good News, the gospel, which is the power of God to save you in every circumstance and every situation, comes because of faith.

Notice the Gospel is the “*power of God unto salvation*”.

Salvation in the New Testament, is generally the Greek word *sōtēria* (so-tay-ree'-ah) and the Greek word for save is *sōzō* (sode'-zo), it has a wonderful meaning of :

Deliverance. Salvation. Preservation. Healing. Provision. my God shall supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

(Php.4:19) Many people limit salvation to such a very narrow band of revelation – but it is very, very big. The Gospel is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believes, not necessarily to what we loosely call “*Christians*” but to the believers, (Rom.1:16)...to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. (17) For therein is revealed a righteousness... ..

- Righteous by Faith!

....because we are counted righteous by our faith, you know the people who walk by faith are the ones who are justified in the New Testament. Our life comes from faith. Our spiritual, heavenly life comes from faith. ...And if he shrink back, my soul hath no pleasure in him. (39) But we are not of them that shrink back unto perdition... (that is destruction) everyone who shrinks back from the walk of faith is being destroyed. They are under the curse, all things that faith delivers us from. ...but of them that have faith unto the saving of the soul. When you first get saved, it is not your soul that gets saved, it is your spirit. And you bear fruit in your soul, as you continue to walk after the spirit. And so he says: “unto the saving of the soul”. Walking by faith brings us the manifestation of God’s salvation in our

soul, which is our mind, will, and emotions. And having them in tune with Jesus Christ is what this salvation is all about. Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. The Really Good News, the gospel, which is the power of God to save you in every circumstance and every situation, comes because of faith. I want to encourage you that you don’t have to talk God into everything. He has already made provision for you, it is a free gift – He puts it in your hand, He gave it to you 2000 years ago and He will not take it back. You can give it up, by not walking by faith, but he wont take it back. Our faith stands in as “*substance*” of the thing that we need. But we need to use the “*substance of the thing hoped for*” and that is our faith.
